**Memorandum of Understanding**


This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) establishes that Big Brothers Big Sisters of Dane County and African Association of Madison, Inc. agree to the following terms and conditions as partners in the "UBUNTU" Volunteer Program.

Big Brothers Big Sisters will:

- Provide program information to African Association of Madison, Inc. members, via in-person presentations and written materials.
- Interview, screen, and make matches between African Association of Madison, Inc. members who have self-identified interest in the "UBUNTU" mentoring program, based on existing BBBS procedures.
- Interview and screen families identified by AAM, and all children who are ready and waiting for a mentor, based on existing BBBS procedures.
- Coordinate one-to-one; couples and family matches between mentors and youth based on existing BBBS procedures.
- Provide supervision and case management for all matches.
- Collaboratively work with African Association of Madison, Inc. members to support one structured event that will promote the BBBS Outreach program.

African Association of Madison, Inc. will:

- Identify members who are most likely to become mentors and arrange opportunities to communicate the program and needs in accordance to Big Brothers Big Sisters written information and/or with a BBBS representative.
- Provide coordinators/contact persons who will communicate the needs and program objectives of the Volunteer Outreach program to African Association of Madison, Inc. members.
- Provide the site for any specific trainings and/or events that are related to this partnership.
- Identify and recommend to BBBS families interested in participating in the AAM "Ubuntu" Mentoring Program.
